



**Rockingham Beach Cup Art Exhibition 2017 Terms & Conditions of Entry.**

- 1) Hanging fee is \$20 per piece, or \$50.00 for 3.
- 2) Maximum of 3 pieces per artist.
- 3) No piece shall exceed 850mm x 850mm size including frame.
- 4) Acceptable mediums: Water colour, Oil, Pastel, Pencil, Acrylic, Pencil, Scraper board, Pen.
- 5) Artists are encouraged to enter their own original work.
- 6) Copying other artists work is acceptable, but must be declared to be a copy of the original.
- 7) Frames must be of a professional standard. Sub-standard frames may be rejected.
- 8) Unframed pieces must also be presented to a professional standard.
- 9) Wet paintings will not be accepted.
- 10) All art will be for sale.
- 11) The organisers will manage all purchases.
- 12) A commission of 15% per item sold will be charged by the organisers.
- 13) All artwork must be delivered to the exhibition marquee on Churchill Park Rockingham by no later than **12pm on Friday the 10th of November**. Late deliveries will not be accepted even if the artist has previously paid the entry fee. No refund will be given.
- 14) The closing date for returning the entry form is **Friday 20<sup>th</sup> of October**. The organisers reserve the right to refuse late entries.
- 15) With your entry form please send a quality, (jpeg) of each piece to [kfahie@bigpond.net.au](mailto:kfahie@bigpond.net.au)  
Please include the name of each piece and its price. Please supply bank account details into which the organisers can deposit funds from purchasers or refunds.
- 16) Payment for sales will be Paid by EFT only within 14 days after the exhibition closes.
- 17) All pieces must be labelled on the back as per the label supplied by the organisers with the entry form.
- 18) All pieces must be ready for hanging by "D" hangers and cord. Any pieces that cannot be hung shall not be accepted. No refund will be given for artwork that cannot be hung.
- 19) All artwork must be collected between **4pm and 5pm on Sunday the 12<sup>th</sup> of November**.
- 20) The organisers will not take any responsibility for uncollected artwork.
- 21) All care will be taken for works submitted, but the organisers will not be liable for damage or loss of any pieces of artwork.
- 22) The organisers reserve the right to not display any artworks considered unsuitable or do not conform to the specified requirements. No discussion will be entered into.
- 23) If the exhibition is oversubscribed, then any artist who is not selected for the display shall be notified and a full refund given. The organiser's decision on who is, or is not selected, shall be final. No discussion shall be entered into.
- 24) People's choice award will be a \$500.00 framing voucher from Tall Poppy Framers.
- 25) The decision on the prize winner shall be final.
